## ARIICLE V: Requirements

Section 1: Any registered student with a cumulative C average or better of FHS is eligible to be elected to represent their class in the student council. The president of each class will also be included as a member of the FHS student council. On the Student Council, the Seniorclass shall have one representative in addition to the class president and the Student Council president, the J unior class shall have one representative in addition to the class president, the Sophomore class shall have one representative in addition to the class president, and the Freshmen class shall have one representative in addition to the class president.

Section 2: Any student who will be a senior with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better is eligible to run for President of the FHSStudent Council. These people will be nominated by the high school teachers on basis of character traits a nd leadership skills.

Section 3: Any student who will be a junior or senior with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better is eligible to run for Vice President of the FHS Student Council.

Section 4: Any student who will be a sophomore, junior, or senior with a GPA of 3.0 or better is eligible to run for sec retary/trea surer of the FHS Student Council.

Section 5: Any student council member may be recommended for removal from his or her office for failure to represent the student council or his or her constituents a ppropriately and/or fa ilure to camy out the duties or any other actions that are detrimental to the school. This will be determined by a two-thirds majority decision of the other council members and approval of the advisor and principal. The Vice President of that class will then take overthat person's position on the student council.

Any student council member who does not maintain a cumulative $C$ average or better, as recorded on report cards, may be removed from office. If a student council member is on the "defic iency" list for 3 weeks in a row, they may be removed from office.

Section 6: Any student council member with 2 unexcused absences will be removed from their position. Two tardies count as one unexcused absence. Each absence will require the memberto write a short note explaining their absence to be given to the advisor upon a mival at school. Failure to do this WITHOUTREMINDING will result in the absence being counted as unexc used.
